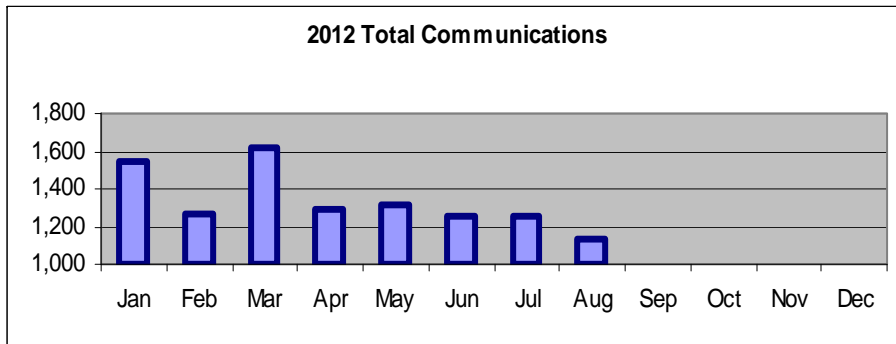



12. POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE MONTH

- On Monday, August 6, 2012, officers and staff provided assistance to a student from Souderton Area High School who organized a 5K Run as part of his twelfth grade community service project. The event started at the Community Park and onto neighboring streets. It became known at the 5K Kick-Off Run for National Night Out. 90 runners participated.
- The police department hosted its 16th annual National Night Out celebration on Tuesday, August 7th. Approximately 3,000 residents and visitors participated in the activities which were capped by a fireworks display that marked the 50th anniversary of the creation of the police department. Administrative Assistant Janice Froshour was responsible for coordinating all of the evening's events.
- Eleven former members of the police department attended a ceremony at the NNO in which they were honored for their past service. Noteworthy attendees included retired Chief Paul Hunsberger and former Officer Gene Davidheiser who were hired by the department in 1965 and 1964, respectively.
