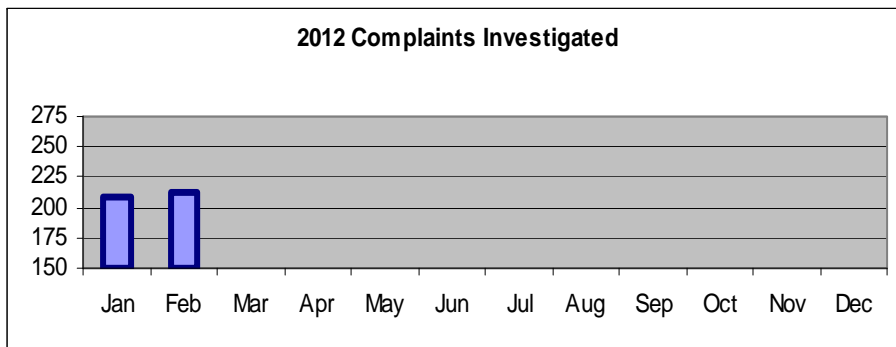
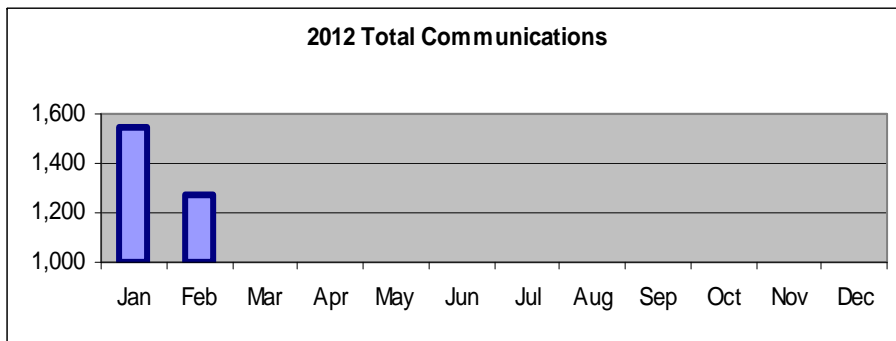



- On February 9th, Det. George Moyer, Cpl. Ed Hall, Cpl. Steve Rinker, and Officer Steve Cronin attended a training class on the Handling of Suicides by Use of Chemicals.
- Detective George Moyer and Officer Cronin attended training updates on Search and Seizure at the County Training Campus.
- On February 24th, Officer Dave Klepfer and Off. Cronin attended training on Child Sex Offenders. All of the above classes were half-day presentations by the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office.
- On the same day, Officer Travis Bivighouse was the Mystery Reader at the Vernfield Elementary School. His identity was kept as a surprise to the students until he entered the classroom. He spent the session reading a book to the students.
- Officers Tim Boyle and Shawn Stiver attended training on vehicle inspection characteristics.
- On February 25th, officers assisted the township Emergency Management Team with the opening of a shelter at the Tylersport Fire House after high winds had toppled several utility poles on Keller's Creamery Road. The officers made notifications to the affected residents who were without power for up to twelve hours. The outage was confined mostly to the area of Morwood Village.
