## **Update to 10/22/07 press release – Subjects Arrested** **Overnight Burglaries to Businesses**

During the overnight hours between Monday, October 22, 2007 and Tuesday, October 23, 2007 two businesses in Franconia Township were burglarized. Both the Franconia Getty Gas Station, located at 303 Harleysville Pike, and the Frank & Brothers Pizza, located at 217 Telford Pike, were burglarized. Police on patrol discovered the break-ins at around one o'clock in the morning. In both cases, windows were broken out to gain entry into the businesses.

Police believed that these incidents were related to similar burglaries of service stations during the same time period in Lower Salford Township and West Rockhill Township.

As a result of police investigations, three subjects have been arrested in connection with these burglaries.

Sean Radcliffe, 18, having no fixed address, was arrested and charged with burglary, criminal trespassing, criminal mischief, theft, receiving stolen property, and conspiracy to commit burglary. He was processed and arraigned before Magisterial District Justice Deborah Lukens on Thursday, February 7, 2008. Bail was set at \$50,000. Radcliffe is currently being held at the Montgomery County Correctional Facility in Eagleville.

Kyle Amwake, 20, of the 100 block of South Second Street in Souderton and Earl Colella, 19, of the same address, were also arrested and charged with burglary, criminal trespassing, criminal mischief, theft, receiving stolen property, and conspiracy to commit burglary. Amwake and Colella were arraigned before Magisterial District Justice Kenneth Deatelhauser on February 7, 2008. Both were released on their own recognizance.

The preliminary hearing for all three individuals is scheduled for March 12, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. at the District Court in Schwenksville.
