Pennsylvania Turnpike to Restrict Schoolhouse Road Weekdays for Several Months for Bridge Construction in Franconia Township

King of Prussia, PA – The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is planning a weekday lane closure with flagging on Schoolhouse Road between Kulp Road and Halteman Road in Franconia Township, Montgomery County beginning Monday, March 9, for bridge construction, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today. Weather permitting, the lane closure will be in place Mondays through Fridays from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM through Friday, November 6.

Motorists are advised to allow extra time when traveling through the work zone because backups and delays will occur. All scheduled activities are weather dependent.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission will complete this project under a PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permit.
