Enclosed for your use are several copies of the Montgomery County Planning Commission's new FY 2015 Transportation Improvement Program brochure. This new Program represents many months of meetings and consensus building by the Southeastern Pennsylvania Counties, PennDOT, SEPTA and DVRPC to prepare a fiscally constrained Twelve-Year Program with \$15 billion of highway and transit improvements.

Over the Twelve-Year Program for Montgomery County, \$1.1 billion is allocated to highway projects along with several hundred million for transit improvements.

All of this is possible because of new state transportation funding provided through Act 89 which was passed by the legislature and signed by the Governor late last year. Many delayed and deferred, large scale projects are moving again thanks to this new funding.

Transportation Improvement Program and FY2015-2026 Twelve-Year Program for Montgomery County Pennsylvania

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Twelve Year Program is a capital program that lists:

- *state and federally-funded projects;*
- *regionally significant projects that are not federally funded, e.g. the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission;*
- *public transit projects, i.e. SEPTA and Pottstown;*
- *bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and;*

Formulation of the list is required by federal law in order to receive and spend federal dollars on transportation projects, however the list is only the authorization to seek project funding. The TIP neither guarantees that funding will be available, nor does it represent a final schedule for project implementation.

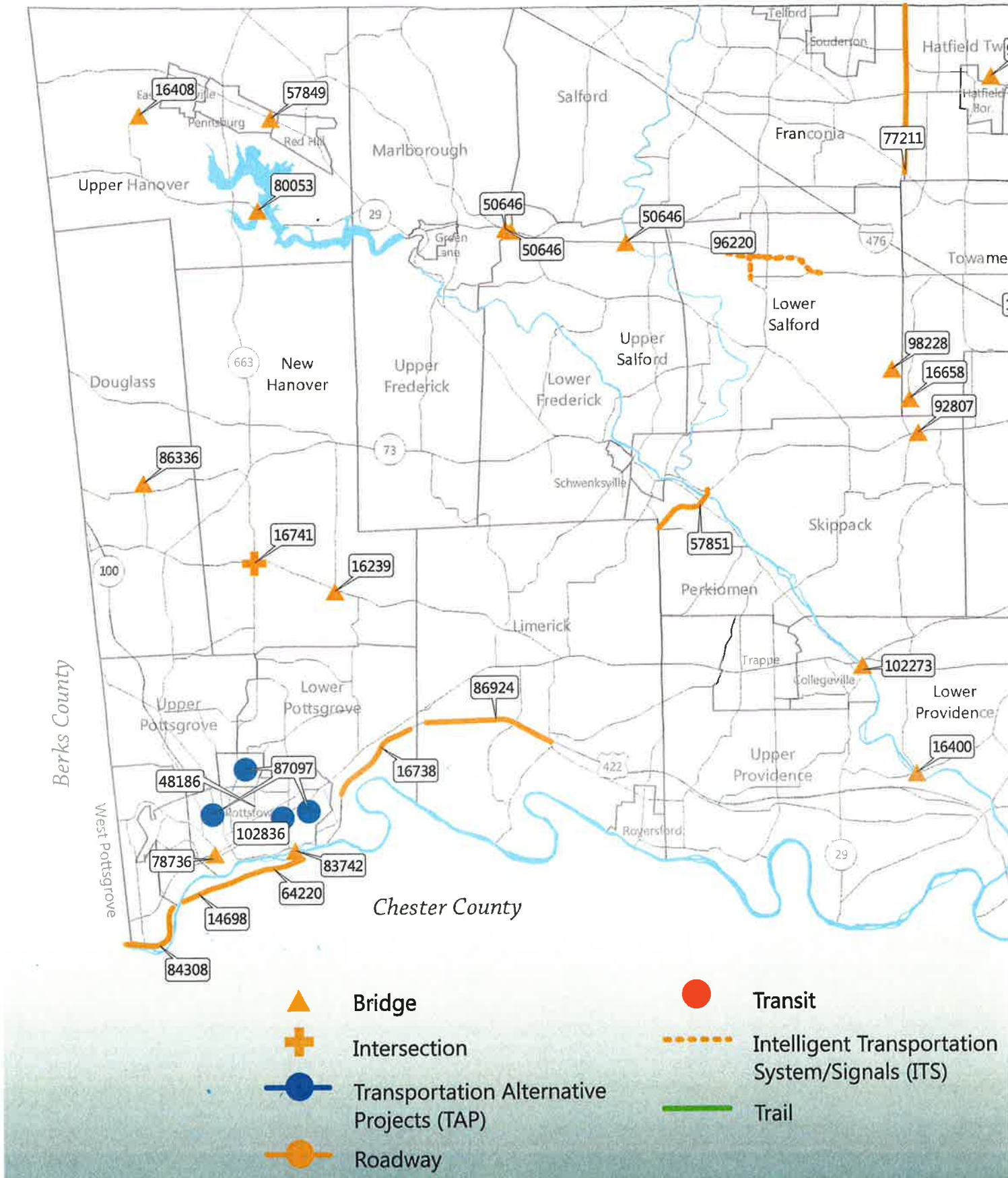
The projects on the TIP are agreed to by a consensus of state, county, and regional officials who concur that they are the most critical near-term improvements that should be pursued with available resources. The list is fiscally constrained, meaning the total cost of the projects cannot exceed the amount of money the region expects to receive in the twelve-year time frame. For FYs 2015 – 2026, southeastern Pennsylvania’s five-county region expects to receive almost \$8 billion in highway funding and \$7.1 billion in transit funding. Over this period, highway projects in Montgomery County total \$1.1 billion with \$403 million in the First Four Years. Transit improvements in the hundreds of millions of dollars include parking garages at Lansdale, Noble, Conshohocken, and Ardmore. Surface lot expansions will occur at North Wales, Gwynedd Valley and Philmont. Rail station improvements include Norristown Transportation Center, Hatboro, Jenkintown, Roslyn, and Willow Grove. Also, significant track and bridge work will occur along with new regional rail cars. Service frequency improvements are targeted for the Manayunk/Norristown Line and the West Trenton Line.



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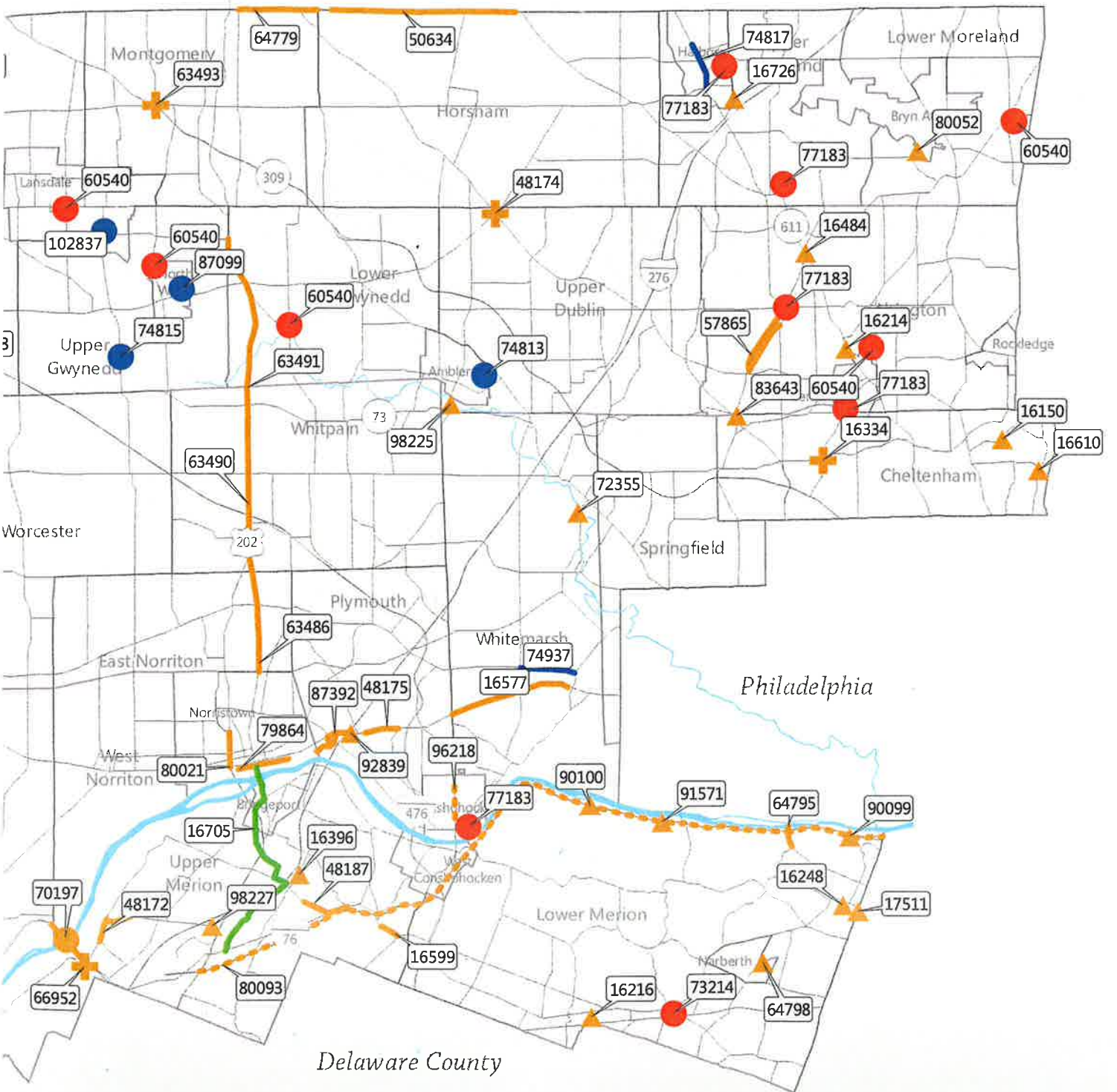
